They will have the following rights:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To attend and vote at general meetings</li> <li>To access the recorder members section of the CRS website</li> <li>To take part in events organised for Recorder Members</li> </ul> <p>Designated Associate Membership classes:</p> <p><b>Friends</b></p> <p><b>Corporate Members</b></p> <p>Members of these classes will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Be invited to attend appropriate meetings and events, but shall not have a vote</li> <li>Receive general circulation newsletters of CRS</li> <li>If the Charity Trustees set a subscription for their class, pay the subscription.</li> </ul> |
